Small Campus Raises Nearly One Thousand Dollars to Help St. Jude

Since 1993, Word of Life’s Primary Campus has taken part in the Math-a-Thon for St. Jude’s Children’s Research Hospital. This year the children collected a total \$968.25. All of the thirty-eight Primary Campus students did the Math-a-Thon booklets to help them practice math skills. Of those thirty-eight, there were only seventeen children who were able to actually collect donations, and there was still nearly one thousand dollars collected. The children completed all of the Math-a-Thon activities by mid-March, and then were honored during a brief assembly in April. Special recognition goes to second grader, Alex Pfeuffer, who collected \$127.25 and third grader, William Moffut, who collected \$250. In the sixteen years that the Primary Campus has participated in this program, they have raised over \$38,000 for St. Jude’s.

Word of Life Lutheran School is a member of the Lutheran Elementary School Association (LESA), a registered, non-profit education organization made up of thirty-seven elementary schools and related agencies in the city of St. Louis, St. Louis county, St. Charles County, Franklin County, and Jefferson County in Missouri, and Madison, Monroe, and St. Clair counties in Illinois.
